












Interreg IPA ADRION 2021/27





- Most of the Programme resources are allocated to **Priority 2**, dedicated to environment.
- **EU Co-financing rate: 85%**
- First Call: from 4 April 2023 to 30 June 2023 at 13:00 CEST/Rome time

Interreg allocation: Approx. **65.7 64 MEUR** out of a total of 136.6 (48%)







Interreg Italy-Croatia 2021/27





- Unchanged area of cooperation (9 Italian regions, 8 Croatian counties)
- Budget: 216.23 M€ (172.98 M€ ERDF) -> about 40% of the resources are allocated to Priority 2, dedicated to the environment
- EU co-financing rate: 80%

The next call will concern strategic projects. It will be launched during the second half of 2023 and will remain open until the first half of 2024



















Strategic projects have priority and programme relevance

Main features:

- high representativeness of the partnerships and extent of the territories involved to ensure that the entire population of the Programme area benefits from the results achieved;
- higher financial allocations than those foreseen for other types of projects;
- specific institutional and technical expertise to ensure a deeper and lasting impact for the entire cooperation area;
- contribution to the implementation of EUSAIR (Flagships).

In this programming period, 6 projects will be financed, one for each of the Specific Objectives of the first four Priority Axes of the Programme
